University's Proposed Contribution Towards Annual Premium for Medical Insurance for Non-Teaching Staff

- ➤ The University proposes to contribute 33% of the premium amount paid for a sum assured of ₹1,00,000 towards the annual medical insurance premium for non-teaching staff.
- ➤ The proposed expenditure will be met from the **Consultancy Staff Welfare Fund**.
- Based on previous years' data, the approximate expenditure per one employee is ₹4,000.
