### **Policy on Research Promotion and Incentives**

A unified policy on research promotion and incentives provides faculty with both monetary and non-monetary benefits to encourage and support research activities, including seed grants, patents, publications, books, book chapters, and e-content development. It also recognizes faculty achievements at state, national, and international levels, fostering a culture of academic excellence. Additionally, the policy outlines financial assistance for faculty participation in professional development opportunities such as conferences, seminars, workshops, short-term training programs, and professional memberships, thereby promoting continuous learning and scholarly growth.

## **Policy on Research Promotion and Incentives**

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## **1. Preamble:**

Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education, Deemed to be University, has undertaken various initiatives over the years to leverage knowledge resources for outcome-based education, research, innovation, and social empowerment. To encourage faculty members for their consistent contributions and outstanding achievements, a policy on **Incentives** has been formulated. This policy covers research projects, publications, patents, books, book chapters, e-content development, state/national/international recognition and awards, as well as financial support for professional development programs such as conferences, seminars, workshops, short-term training programs, and the acquisition of professional memberships. The policy has been in effect since the academic year 2025-26.

## **2. Objectives of the Policy**

The Incentives Policy of Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education, Deemed to be University aims to promote excellence in research, innovation, and professional growth among faculty members, Students and research scholars. The objectives of the policy are to:

- Motivate faculty to engage in research alongside teaching, publishing in reputed international and national journals with impact factors.
- Encourage writing books and monographs for publication by esteemed national and international publishers.
- Promote collaborative research with reputed institutions, universities, and laboratories.
- Support faculty in securing funded research projects from Indian and international agencies, focusing on socially impactful outcomes.
- Foster creativity and innovation, leading to patents and interdisciplinary research contributions.
- Inspire faculty to develop e-content and contribute to government-led higher education initiatives.
- Recognize and encourage faculty to achieve state, national, and international awards.
- Facilitate participation in faculty development programs, including conferences, seminars, workshops, and short-term training.
- Encourage researchers to apply for memberships and fellowships in prestigious national and international societies.
- Encourage Students and research scholars to present their innovations or research outputs in reputed institutes like IIT's and NIT's.

Finally this policy fosters a culture of innovation and academic excellence, ensuring faculty members receive due recognition and motivation for their contributions.

### 3. Incentives for external funded Research Projects:

In order to encourage the faculty members, incentives are provided for the research projects. The incentive amount will be released upon the submission / certification of Utilization Certificate. The incentive distribution aims to encourage faculty members to secure grants, engage in impactful research, and contribute to innovation and societal development.

The incentive amount for research projects received from National Funding Agencies (UGC, AICTE, DST, SERB, etc.) will be structured based on the funding received. The distribution will be as follows:

- $\leq ₹ 25\text{Lakhs} \rightarrow 10\%$  of the sanctioned amount
- $\leq ₹ 50\text{Lakhs} \rightarrow 10\%$  of the 25Lakhs + 7.5% of the sanctioned amount above 25Lakhs
- $> ₹ 50\text{Lakhs to } 100\text{Lakhs} \rightarrow 10\%$  of the 25Lakhs + 7.5% of the 25Lakhs + 5% of the sanctioned amount above 50Lakhs and less than 100Lakhs.
- $> ₹ 100\text{Lakhs} \rightarrow 10\%$  of the 25Lakhs + 7.5% of the 25Lakhs + 5% of the 50Lakhs + 2.5% of the sanctioned amount above 100Lakhs.

### 4. Incentives for patents granted (Utility Patents):

To encourage faculty members to secure more patents, the university provides incentives for granted patents, in addition to covering the expenses for patent filing. For each patent granted, faculty members will receive an incentive of ₹10,000 as a token of appreciation and encouragement.

### 5. Incentives for Publications:

Incentives are awarded for the research articles published in SCI/SCIE indexed journals. This is in order to motivate the faculty members to publish their research articles in SCI/SCIE indexed journal.

**6. Financial Support to attend Professional Development programs like Conferences, Industrial training programs, FDPs, seminars, workshops, short term training programs etc., and acquisition of professional memberships**

**7. Financial Support for Journal Publications (Open Access)**

Financial support for open access fees is available to all faculty members of Siddhartha University who are supervising scholars under Siddhartha University. Only high-quality open access journals with an impact factor will be considered. Siddhartha University will cover **maximum of 25,000/-** of the open access fee for one publication per student. In the publications, the research scholar shall be the first author and the guide shall be the corresponding author. Faculty members shall obtain written approval from the Dean Research and Development concerned before submitting his/her paper to open access journals. **There is no incentive for this type of publications.**

## **8. Incentive for development of E-content**

To encourage innovation and enhance digital teaching resources, the university will provide incentives to faculty members who develop high-quality e-content. This includes, but is not limited to, video lectures, virtual labs, interactive modules, digital textbooks, and online assessment tools.

**Eligible content must meet the following criteria:**

- Align with the university's prescribed curriculum.
- Be original, pedagogically sound, and technically well-produced.
- Be hosted on approved platforms such as the university's LMS, national repositories (e.g., SWAYAM, NPTEL), or other recognized educational platforms.

**Undergo review and approval by the E-Content Review Committee constituted by the university.**

Faculty will receive an **incentive amount of 25,000/-** for complete course and certificates of appreciation.

## **9. Seed Money for Faculty Members**

A grant of the research seed money **up to Rs.3 Lakhs** is given to the full-time faculty members of Siddhartha University **once in three years**. This support is intended to facilitate high impact research that can lead to quality publications and patents. The call for seed grant research proposals would be made by Dean Research, Technology & Development, twice in a year in the months of January and July. All proposals received would be evaluated for their quality by a committee headed by Dean Research, Technology & Development and recommended applicants will receive the seed grant. The **Project period is maximum of two years** from the date of sanction and is expected to be conducted by the faculty member himself or herself.

## **10. Incentives to faculty members who Receiving Awards**
