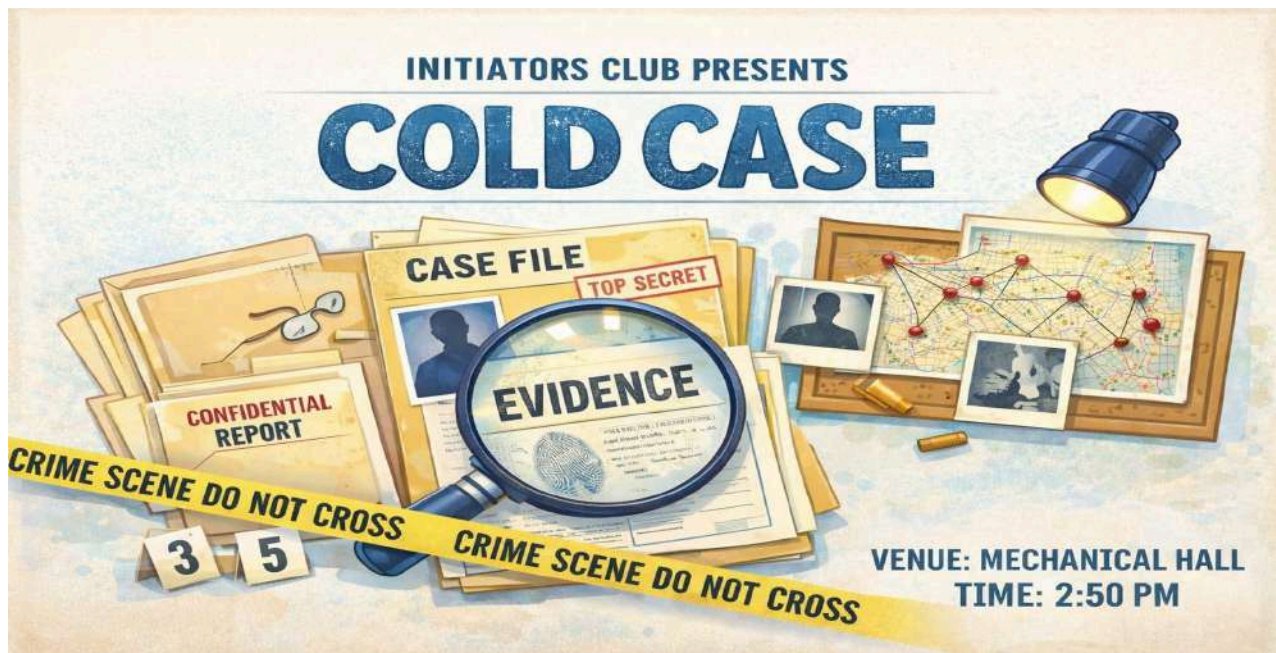


# REPORT ON “COLD CASE”

The responses reflect effective planning and seamless coordination, ensuring a well-structured and uninterrupted event experience.



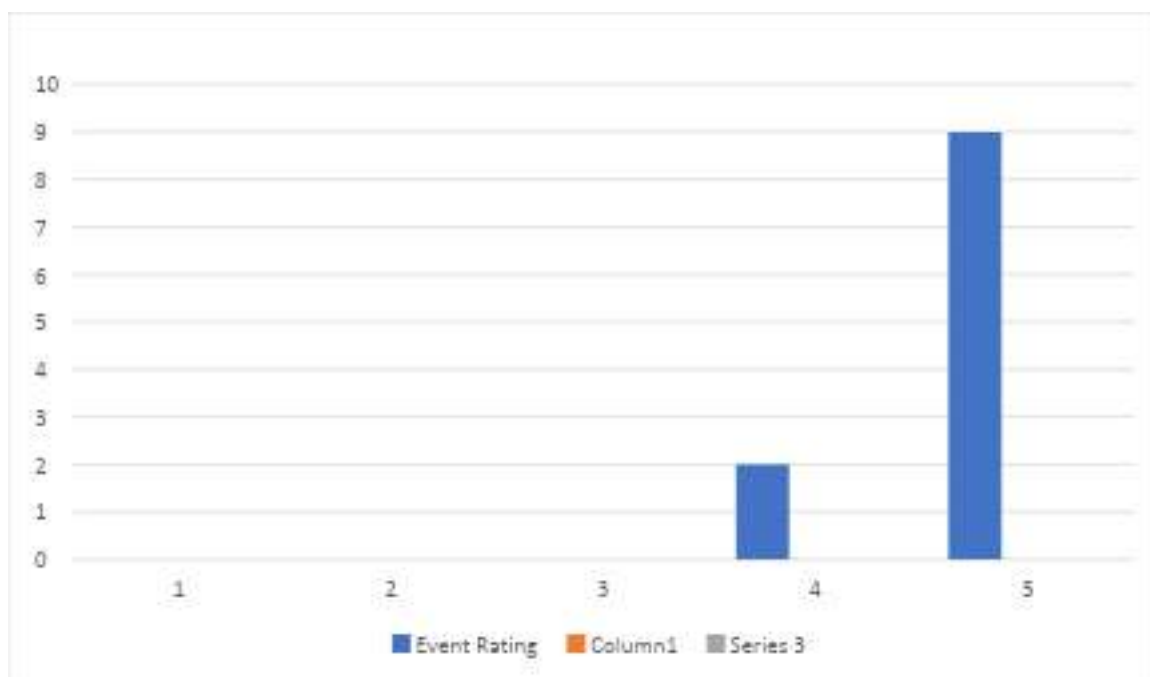
## 2. Event Rating

## 3. Engagement Level

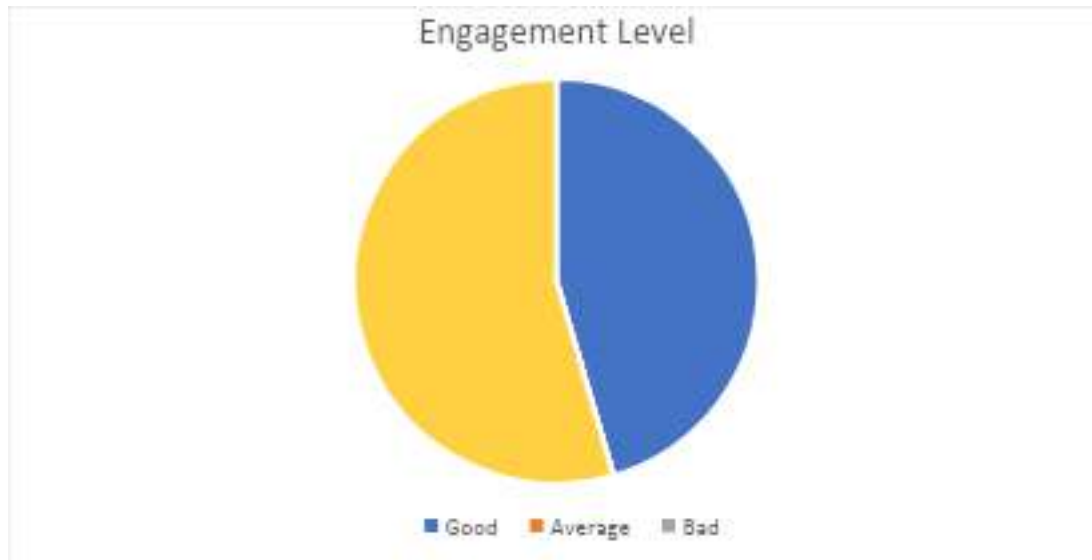
### Overview:

#### 4. Enjoyment of the Activity

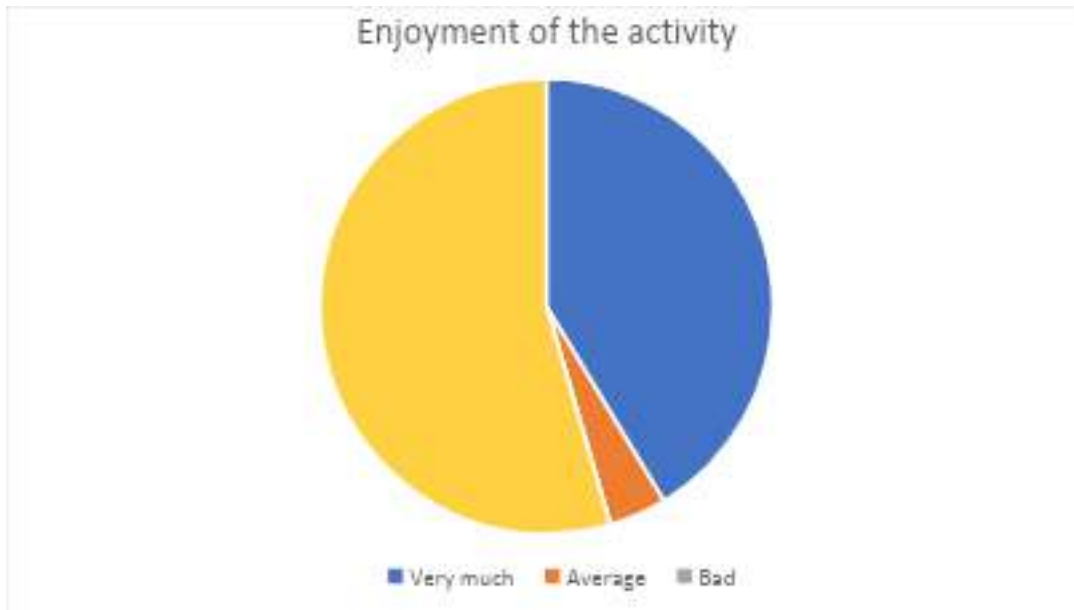
##### Overview:
