Resolutions

1. Discussed the CO, PO & PSO attainment levels and the comments made by the Course coordinators in FCAR reports of the courses in A.Y: 2024-25 and measures to improve the attainments
2. The target pass percentage of 60% was not achieved in the 1st and 2nd year during the academic year 2024–25, primarily due to lower pass percentages in analytical subjects when compared to the academic year 2023–24. Remedial classes will be conducted for students struggling in analytical subjects. Weak students will be identified based on their performance in internal examinations, and special remedial sessions will be arranged to improve their academic outcomes.
