Minutes of Meeting of the 8th Executive Council held on 29th June, 2026

Prof. P. Venkateswara Rao, Vice Chancellor, chaired the **8th Executive Council** meeting and welcomed all the members. He mentioned that the academic classes for the B. Tech. II Year students commenced on 17th June, 2026, and for the III Year students on 22nd June, 2026. He further informed that the classes for the I Year students will commence shortly.

He also shared that students secured placements, with the highest packages reflecting their commitment and university's strong placement performance. Further, he highlighted the increase in the publication of journal papers and conference papers, reflecting the faculty members' contributions to quality research.

He informed the progress of the ongoing construction of the Girls' Hostel, Administrative Block, Academic Block, and other infrastructure development works on the campus. He also stated that the construction of the 5th Floor of the Dr. V. L. Dutt Block was nearing completion and that it will be put to use during the Academic Year 2026-27.

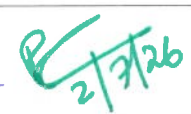
